Playing Field	The playing field with play equipment is 100m down Hook Lane on the right hand side. The playing field is maintained by the Parish Council.
Post Office	The nearest Post Offices are in Bishop Sutton, West Harptree and Clutton.
Public Access Defibrillator	Hinton Blewett has a defibrillator located in the centre of the village outside Church Cottage and next to the Ring O Bells pub. In the event of an emergency 999 callers will be directed to the defibrillator and given instructions for use. The defibrillator was upgraded in 2014 thanks to generous donations from local residents. It is owned and insured by the Parish Council.
