- 22/812 <u>PUBLIC PARTICIPATION</u> There was none.
- 22/813 <u>APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE</u> Apologies were received and accepted from Councillor D Elliot, A Mills and J O'Nains.
- 22/814 <u>DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST</u> There were none.
- 22/815 <u>CONFIRMATION OF MINUTES</u> **Resolved** – that the minutes of the meeting held on 4th November 2021 were confirmed as a true record and signed by the Chairman.

22/816 <u>REPORTS</u>

Ward Councillor – B&NES are presently doing their budget. The services that have an impact on Hinton Blewett residents such as road repairs, flooding and recycling are being considered and protected in the budget to enable these front line services to be kept. Emission Charges – there will be a series of exemptions which include Blue Badge holders, travel to hospital, including visitors, and those on lower incomes travelling to work. Local Plan – houses to be located in areas where there are transport links. The resurfacing with be extended from Lower Road along to Hook Lane.

Chairman – there has been more vandalism at Prospect Stile. A conversation has been had with Western Power in respect of the power cuts in some parts of the village. They have said that they will look into this.

Climate and Nature Emergency working group – a verbal update was provided. A survey – WECA Supported Bus Services Survey has been sent out for completion.

22/818 <u>2022/2023 DRAFT BUDGET</u>

It was agreed to remove the amount for the Village Pound and add a new budget line for the Queens Jubilee.

Resolved – that with the above changes the draft budget was approved. The final decision will be made at the January 2021 Council meeting where the level of precept agreed.

22/819 <u>RISK ASSESSMENT 2021/2022</u>

Resolved – that the Risk Assessment for 2020/2021 was reviewed and approved with one minor amendment changing a risk level from low to medium.

22/820 GRANT REQUEST

Resolved – that the village hall is requested to complete the Councils grant application form.

22/821 <u>MUD ON ROADS</u>

A satisfactory reply has been received which will be passed onto B&NES Council subject to permission being given.

22/822 <u>SEWERAGE IN THE VILLAGE</u>

It was agreed to write to Bristol Water, Wessex Water and Western Power to ask if there is capacity in the village for the sewerage. It was felt that the Council should be aware of the situation which would be especially useful when considering planning applications.

22/823 NEWSLETTER FEEDBACK

There has been positive feedback from residents. There will be another issue and it is hoped that the next one will be issed in January/February which will include details of the budget and the Jubilee celebrations.

22/824 RECRUITMENT OF NEW CLERK

Resolved – that the recruitment of the new qualified Clerk, Philip Edwards, as the Proper Officer and RFO of the Council was approved at a rate of pay of SCP17-20 (£12.69 to £13.47), starting on SCP18 (£12.95) with a review after 3 months to increase to SCP20 £13.47.

Resolved - that the new Clerk, Philip Edwards, is added to the Councils bank Unity Trust as an administrator to the account and that J Swift is removed.

22/825 INTERNAL AUDITOR

Resolved – that the appointment of Bridget Bowen as the Internal Auditor for 2021/2022 at a cost of £180.00 was approved.
